## IN THE GLASS...

With a nice presentation, this deep ruby red colored wine is limpid. The nose displays red berry and plum aromas, with underwood scents. On the palate, the attack is supple and round. This vintage is an early drinking bottle.

Blending : 50% Merlot 45% Cabernet Sauvignon 5% Petit Verdot  
100% aged in french oak barrels (40% new)

## THE TERROIR

Neighbouring the famous Château Loudenne, on clayey-calcareous soils.  
Vines 40 years old on average !  
Good sized vineyard with 43,5 ha of vines.  
Controlled yield giving a 40 hl/ha on average.  
Experimental organic culture on 5 hectare vineyard...
